# **Activity Report**

The govt of kerala launched the scholar support programme in our college from 2014 scholar support programme aims at imparting personalized additional support to needy students through tutorials, study materials, additional lectures question banks etc. funds are allotted to colleges for the implementation of the programme for 50 selected students, the students were also provide study materials, stationary kits, tea and snacks and travel expenses from the university fund. According to the wish of students, the college provided classes for English, Maths, Managerial Economics, Linguistics and Financial Accounting.

### First Year

A scholar support programme was conducted among first year students from December 2015 to March 2016. According to the wish of students, the college provided classes for English, Maths, Managerial Economics, Linguistics, Methodology and Perspectives of Business Education and Financial Accounting.

For the first year 5 subjects were selected and one of them are English. The other subjects decided by the college council as per the need of the students . a total of 16 sessions of one hour duration may be conducted for first and second semester . Our college campus comprises of four departments namely B.Sc Chemistry, BA Islamic History, Bcom Cooperation and Bcom Tourism and Travel Management. From each department ten students were selected for the respective subjects. Biodata of the students were collected to get a detailed understanding of them. The classes usually held on Saturdays. For the well being of the students resource persons gave them assignments conducted test papers, valued their answer sheets. A re-test is held for the students who obtain less mark.

The college receives positive response from the part of students and teachers. Apart from the selected students, some other students who feel the subject difficult also participate in this programme. There are some students who are financially back and so they cannot afford for private tuition. Such students make this opportunity to grasp the subjects easily. The scholar support programme helps to attain great progress for the students and also for our college.

#### **Second Year**

A scholar support programme was conducted among second year students from December 2015 to March 2016. As per the need of students, the class has been arranged for Maths, English, Linguistics and Accounting. Ten students each were selected for different subjects. All the faculty members collected the bio data of students which helps them to understand them in detail. Usually all the sessions are arranged on Saturdays which helps in better learning of students. The faculty members gave assignments on different topics. This helped them activity based learning. Due to the time limitations, small topics were allotted to them. Apart from these, test papers were also conducted which developed a healthy competition among them. Remedial teaching and retest are provided to weak students.
