### **Activity Report**

#### **First Year**

A scholar support programme was conducted among first year students from December 2016 to March 2017. According to the wish of students, the college provided classes for English, Maths, Managerial Economics, Linguistics, Methodology and Perspectives of Business Education and Financial Accounting.
