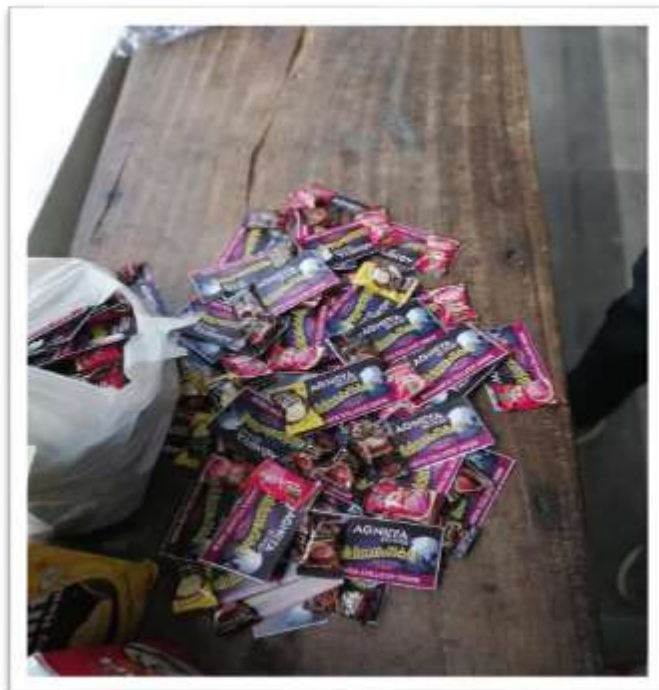
1. 7th November 2019 – ‘**Name Suggestion Contest**’ for the college union (AGNEYA)

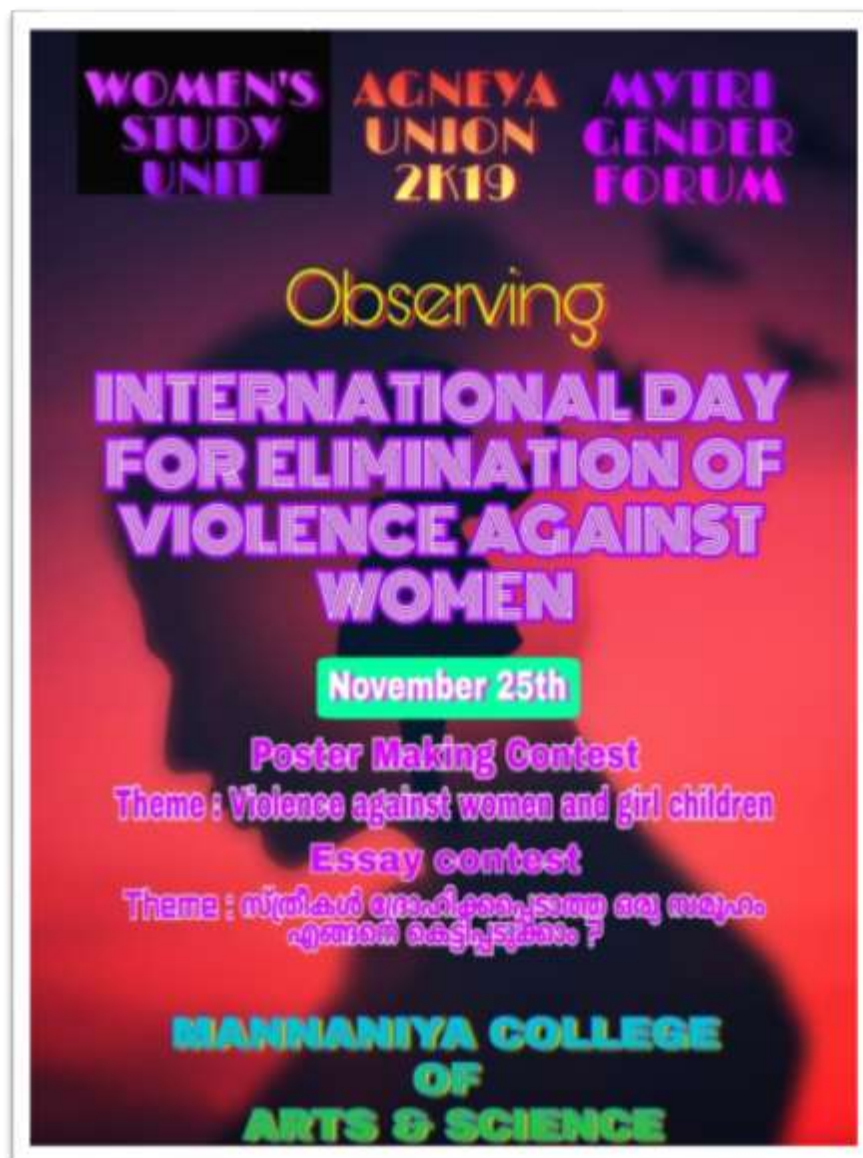

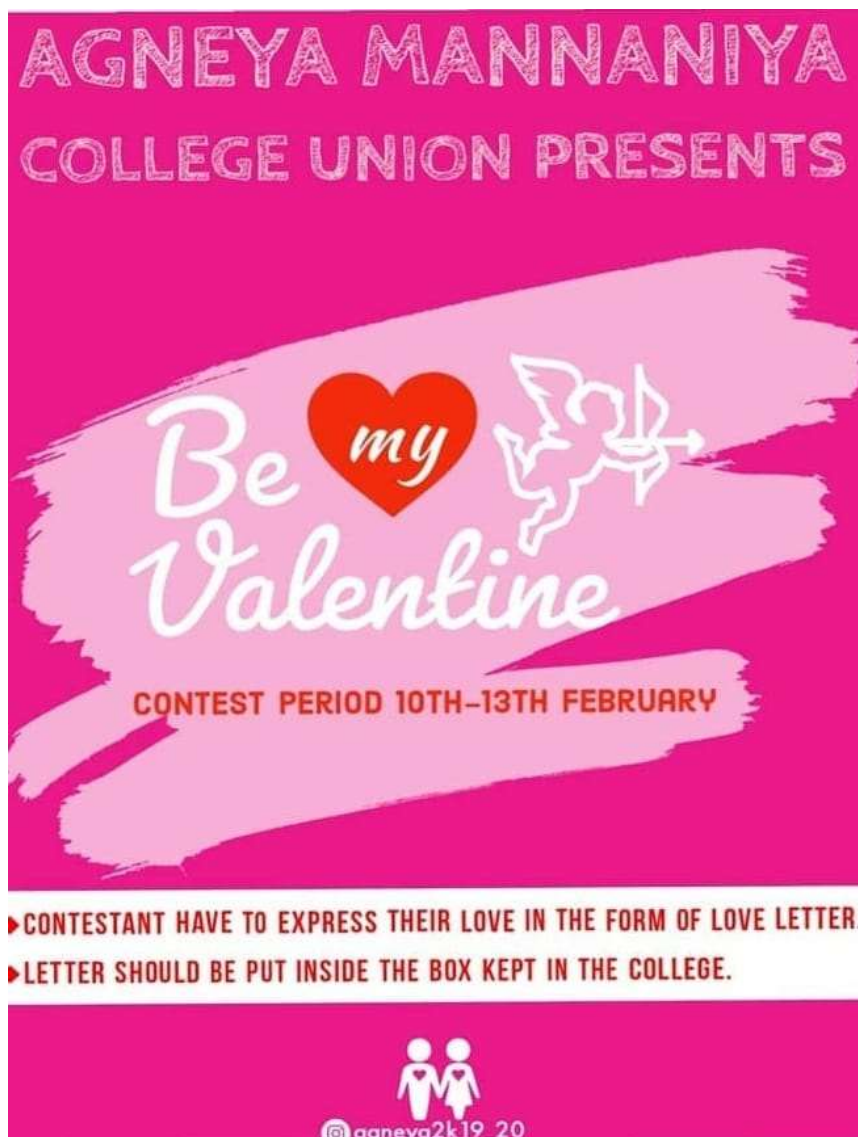




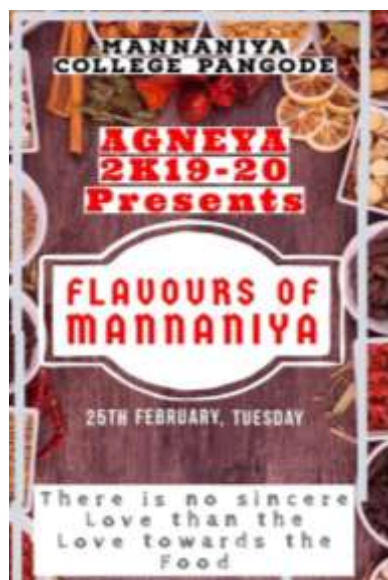
