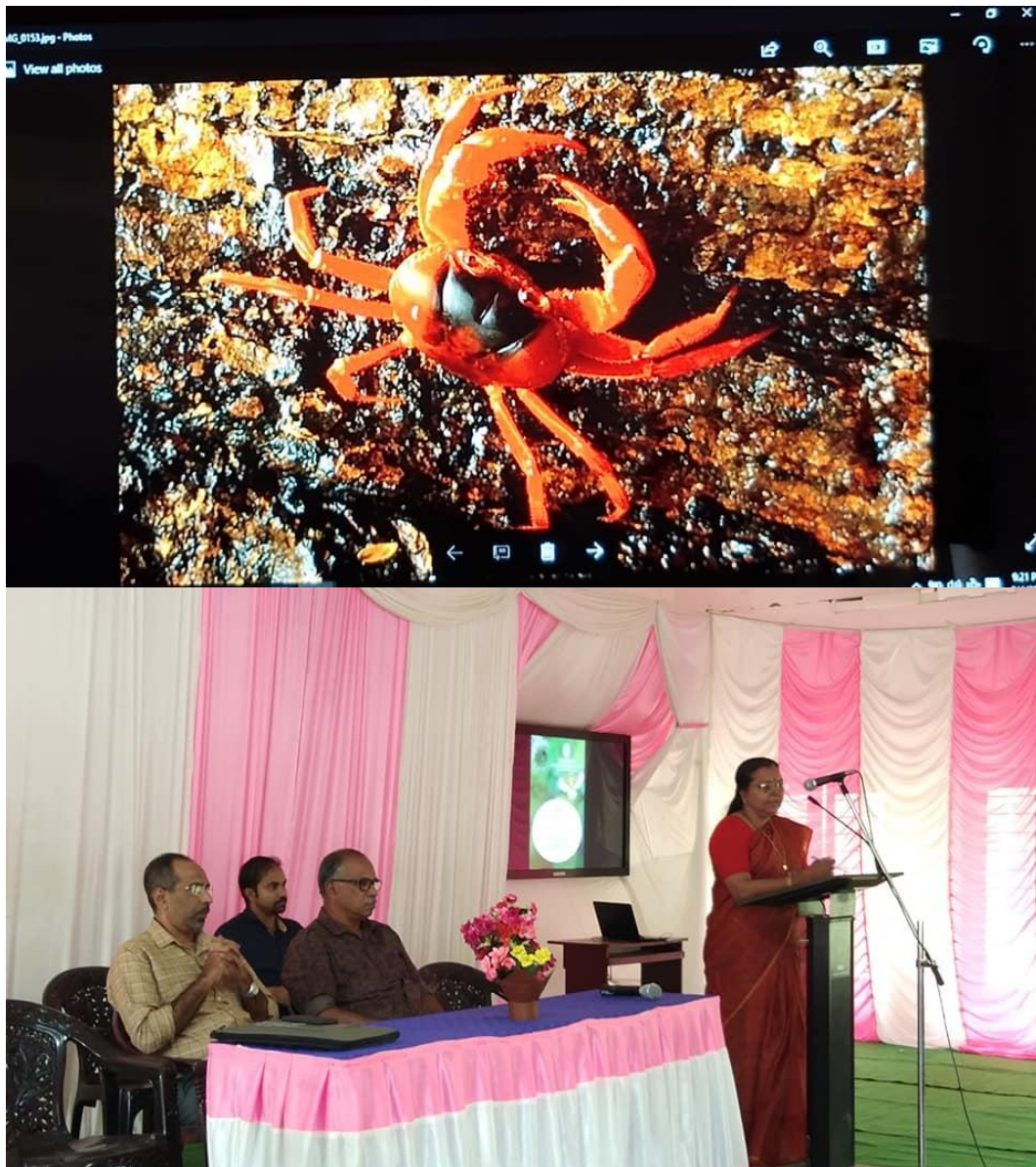


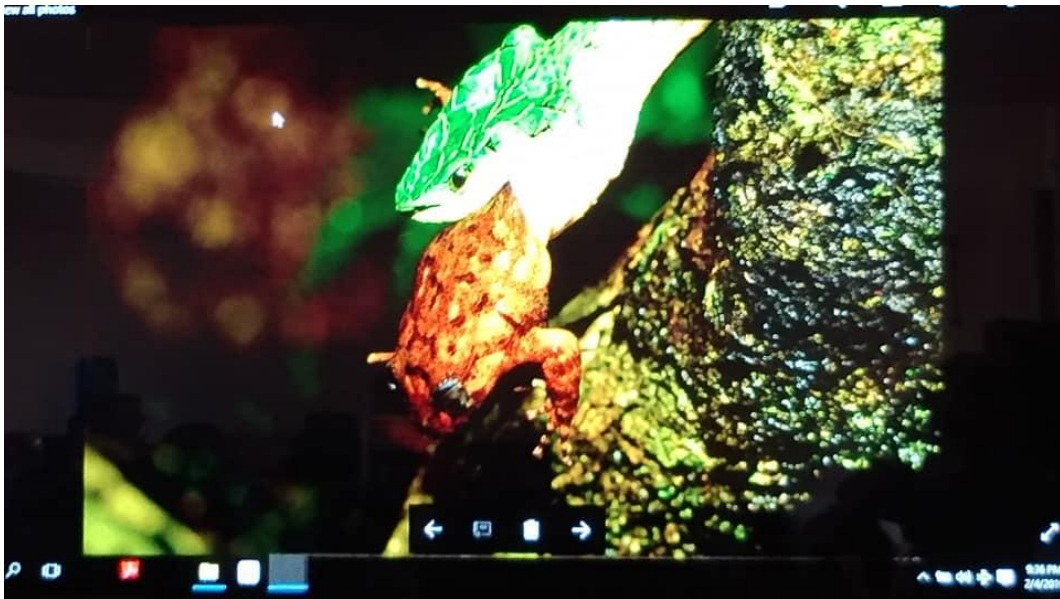
### **Invited Talk- Wild Life Tourism & Poster Exhibition**
