

One Day Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights (9th April 2019)

In today's globally competitive environment, intellectual property has placed itself on a pedestal in the context of economic growths and is becoming increasingly important. Intellectual property is the fuel that powers the engine of prosperity, fostering invention and innovation. In order to take forward the national IPR policy and to enhance creativity, innovation, competitiveness and economic growth in India, it is imperative to harness intellectual property.
