

## 1. Martyr's Day (30-01-2019)

Martyrs day is marked every January 30 on the death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of the nation. Mahatma Gandhi - who was assassinated on January 30, 1948 - led the country's freedom struggle with his non-violence movement. Mahatma Gandhi was assassinated by Nathuram Godse on January 30 and the day is today known as Martyrs day.
