

Palliative care services

It is an initiative to inculcate empathy and humanity among volunteers. The unit consisted of 15 volunteers having genuine interest in social service activities. The team visits old age people with terminal and ageing related diseases, bedridden patients, senior citizens who need a psychological support and spend time with them. The unit started in the year 2018. We are planning to expand these activities by collaborating with Pallium India. Final discussions are going on for the collaboration. **Pallium India** is a national registered charitable trust formed in 2003 for compassionate, high quality palliative care. Pallium India brings support and relief to those in pain through its network of care centers. Pallium India strengthens families and society by putting an end to the needless suffering endured by millions in India who are denied pain relief and appropriate medical care.

Pallium India also works with Central and State Governments for

- integrating palliative care into the Health Care System
- facilitating palliative care education and
- improving access to essential and affordable medicines like morphine and other opioids
- conducting need-based research, and
- disseminating information
