

## Walk With a Scholar(WWS) Programme

### Activity Report 2019-20

Walk With a Scholar (WWS) is a new initiative of higher education by collegiate education, Govt of Kerala, started in the academic year 2012-13. This scheme proposes to arrange specialized mentoring programs for students in under graduate to provide guidance for their future. The scheme introduces the idea of mentoring and builds on the concept of mentor as a 'Guide' and 'Friend'. The mentoring scheme for students will be purely voluntary in nature. It will be open for all students entering the first year of the under graduate programme of study. The Scheme aims at giving necessary orientation to needy students, to prepare them for employment and give them necessary guidance, motivation and necessary mental support to identify appropriate areas for higher study as well as employment. The mentoring scheme should be planned to identify the opportunities available for the scholars, the areas suitable for them, the manner in which the scholar should proceed before them and evolve ways by which they can be acquired. The scheme involves internal mentoring, external mentoring, motivational visit to reputed educational institutions, leadership camps, internship with civil servants etc.

A total of 90 mentees were enrolled in WWS in the academic year 2019-20

### **Internal mentoring**

Internal mentoring is a specialized and focused mentoring in a ratio 1:6. Each mentor supported six mentees throughout the academic year. A total of 15 internal mentors engaged 90 mentees. 10 internal mentoring sessions for first year mentees , 7 for second year mentees and 6 sessions for third year mentees respectively. The main activities of internal mentoring were debates, discussion, mock interviews, book reviews, newspaper discussion , quiz competitions, assignments for personal growth etc



### **External mentoring**

The main weaknesses of the mentees are emotional imbalance, stage fear, communication problem and Lack of confidence. External mentoring session was organized in such way that the mentees can overcome this kind of problems. The interactive session given by them gave more importance to solve the problem of stage fear, communication, confidence of mentees. Special Emphasis was given to motivate and create more confidence among mentees to avail better future opportunities. Legal awareness, Personality development, Career counseling, Orientation for preparing competitive examinations were the main activities of the external mentoring.
