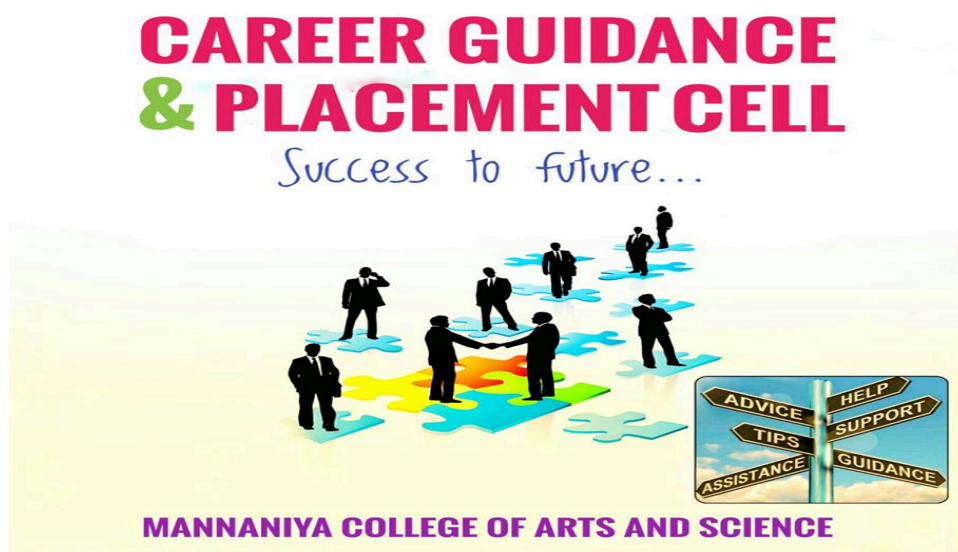

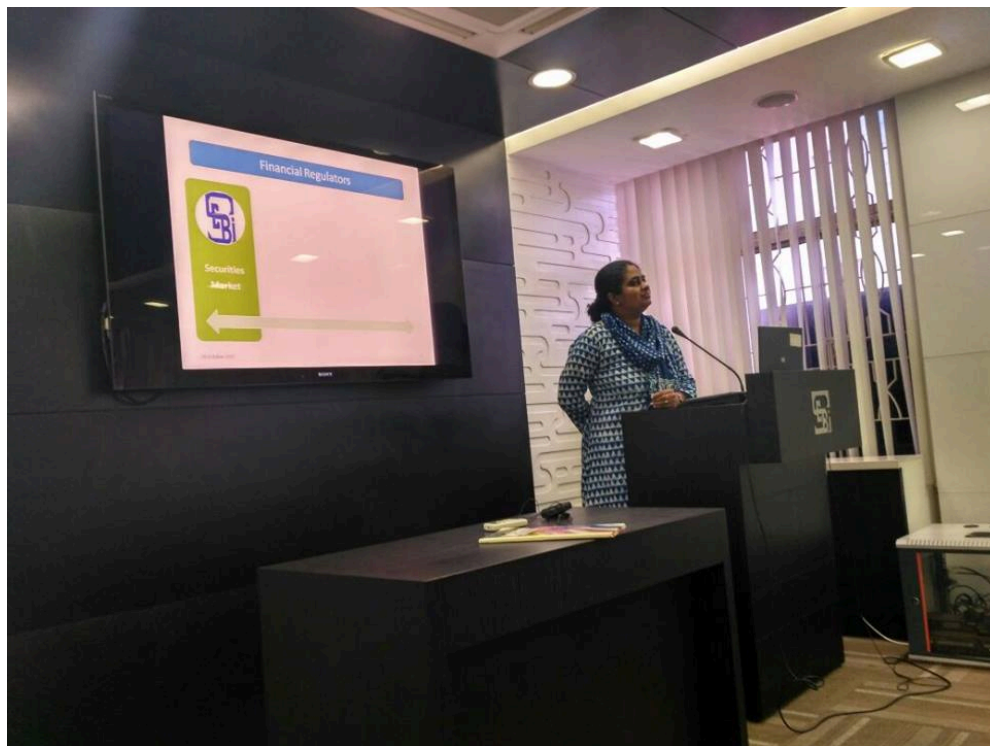

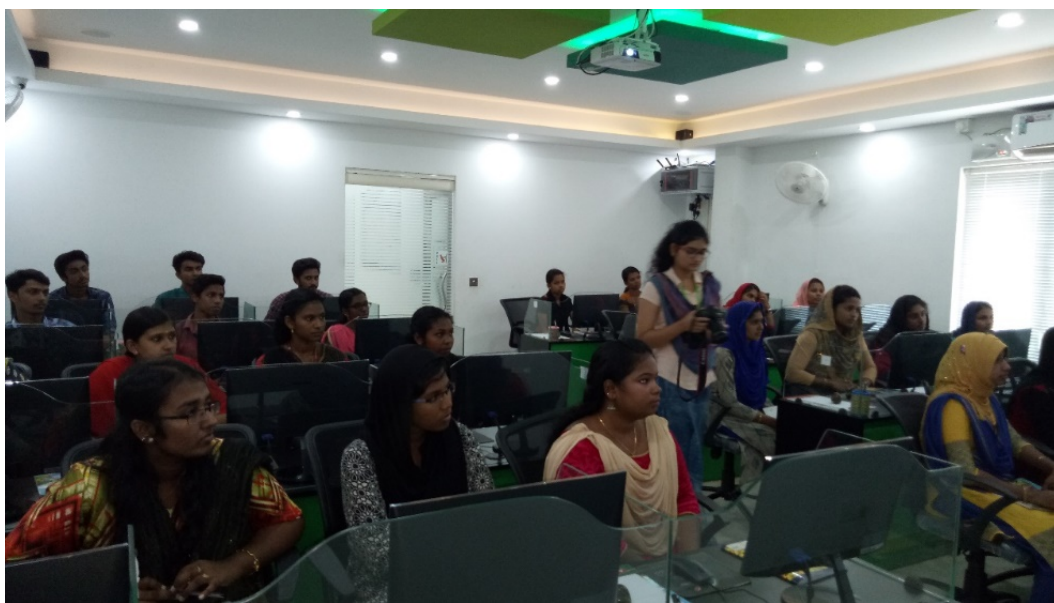


On 21st January 2018, sixteen final year BCom and TTM students attended in ICAI commerce wizard talent search online test @ TALROP IT center, pazhavila





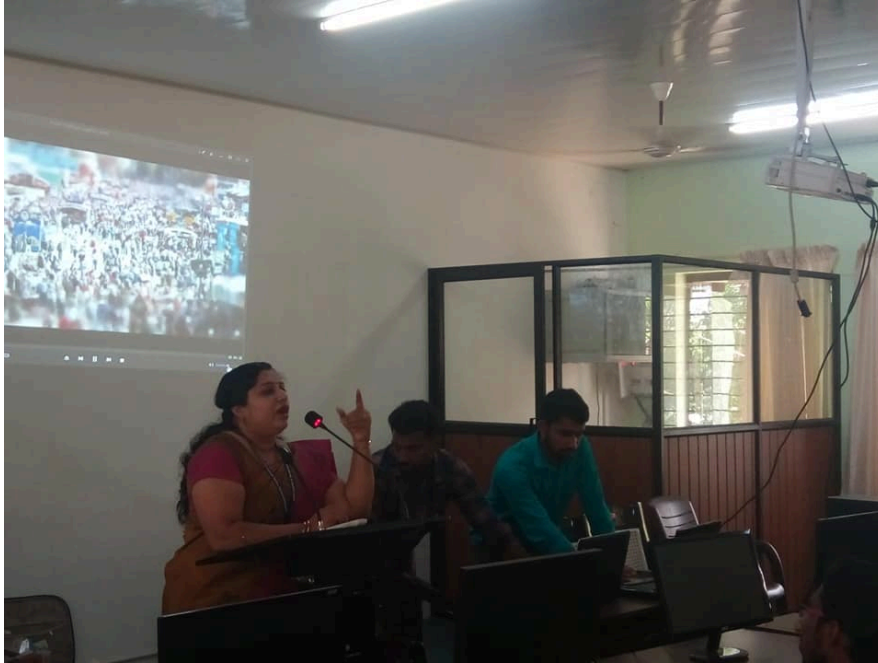
On March 18, 2018, Amal, software engineer, Talrope company limited, organized a training for teachers on the topic: ICT in teaching and learning process
