The duties and responsibilities of the parties to this agreement forming part of MOU are highlighted below;

HTPSF RESPONSIBILITIES

- HTPSF conducts and implements various programmes under "Teens' Track" framework by giving training to the students, volunteers etc.,
- Addressing the parents and giving them training and counseling will foster them in effective parenting, which in turn helps them to improve their children's behavior.
- Helping MCAS in enlisting the resource persons.
- Acts as an intermediate between college, children and parents.
- Periodically review the performance of the students.
- Enlisting the Professional Counselors, Psychologist, and Motivational speaker for training and giving counseling to the students.
- Providing Psychotherapy to the students and parents to cope with difficult situation in a more adaptive way.
- Enabling Teachers/Mentors/Volunteers to easily identify the problems of the students and making them to enrich the students' mental health.
- The whole programme will be periodically evaluated and scientifically monitored using a structured protocol and a pre -post research design.
- Assisting MCAS in facilitating joint resource mobilization.
- Preparation of Performance Reports thus helping MCAS in enhancing and transforming the lives of the underprivileged students in that community.



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MCAS RESPONSIBILITIES

- Providing Classroom for Community school.
- Providing Teaching staffs or Trainees or Volunteers from Mannaniya College of Arts and Science.
- Catering Equipment for sports like Chess, Table Tennis, Carrom etc.,
- Resourcing Trainees or Volunteers from various walks of life or those who interested in enlightening the lives of the marginalized children.
- Facilitating the Enlisted resource persons, psychologist and counselors for all the activities along with HTPSF also providing them with Honorarium.
- Providing instructors or trainers for teaching extracurricular activities like Music, Dance, Painting etc.,
- Enabling the Trainees/Teachers for giving Vocational training in diverse fields like Health care, Computer, Fashion etc.,
- Providing other basic infrastructure facilities (Eg: Washroom for both girls and boys, Water facility)
- Facilitation of smart class rooms.
- Facilitating joint resource mobilization.
- This Partnership should form a core committee to ensure the smooth functioning of this project and the core committee will monitor the activities undertaken in this MCAS

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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Heaven Tree Philanthropy Services Forum (HTPSF)

And

Mannaniya College of Arts and Science (MCAS), Pangode-Thiruvananthapuram.

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into by HTPSF and MCAS.

I. DESCRIPTION OF PARTNER AGENCIES

- A. HTPSF a non-profit organisation registered under section 8 of companies' act 2013. It has its objectives to promote educational development to marginalised section of the community, along with other objectives in its social development mission.
- B. MCAS is in the field of Education and is committed to promote community development of the immediate neighbourhood, in assisting the students belonging to the marginalised section.

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II. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

As detailed in the agreement forming part, this MOU mutually facilitate in organising and conducting perpetually, the community school, with the aim and objectives of assisting marginalised and underprivileged adolescent school children of the surrounding locality, in the manner and scope as defined in the agreement.



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III. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES
