Student feedback analysis report 2018-19

Overall feedback of 350 students were collected during the academic year 2018-19. The overall structure of the feedback was ratings based on the different choices which varied from excellent to poor. They had to mark any one criterion which they felt appropriate. For rating calculation and analysis purpose, feedback criterions had been given weight age in the following manner:

Excellent (5), Very Good(4), Good(3), Average(2), Poor(1).

The first aspect consist of feedback on the availability of academic support, teachers approachability at all times, facilities in the library for students, satisfaction with service from the office staff and satisfaction regarding the laboratory facilities. Majority of the students ticked 'yes' opinion towards the above mentioned criterions.

The second part was concentrated on teacher evaluation

The rating about the knowledge of all teachers were 90%. The rating on the question about the teaching method and classroom management was 85%. On the aspect of encouragement and punctuality of teachers, students rating was 80%.

Students have some suggestions regarding the academic limitations of the college such as:

- 1. New UG and PG courses in all departments
- 2. More approachable facilities on the library
- 3. New teaching learning methods
- 4. BA Islamic History students complained their subsidiary language (Liguistics) to be much difficult for them to study.

Action Plan

Based on the suggestions and opinions reviewed by IQAC, the following recommendations were subjected to Principal for immediate action

- 1. To propose for new course applications to The University of Kerala
- 2. To start e- learning resources in the library
- 3. To enhance the class room teaching to ICT enabled ones.
- 4. To seek to change the complimentary subject from linguistics to economics

All the suggestions made by IQAC are approved by the Principal and implemented thereafter.

- 1. Applications for New UG (B.Sc Physics) PG(M.Sc Chemistry) courses were sent to University of Kerala through the Manager.
- 2. Library was upgraded with NLIST and other e- resources.
- 3. Well equipped smart class rooms with ICT facilities were set up.
- 4. Application was forwarded to the university of Kerala for changing the subsidiary subject of BA Islamic History from Linguistics to Economics.

Student feedback analysis report 2017-18

Overall feedback of 300 students were collected during the academic year 2017-18. The first section covers questions regarding the academic support culture, approachability of teachers, library facilities, administrative services of office staffs and regarding the lab facilities including computer lab and Chemistry laboratory. About 90% of the students were satisfied with the existing ambience of the college. Some of the students are not satisfied with the administrative culture of the college.

The second section was concentrated on teacher evaluation

The rating about timely completion of portions, teaching method, classroom management, encouragement/motivation, knowledge level and punctuality of teachers were regarded. For analysis purpose, the rating criterion had been given the following measures- Excellent, very good, good, average and poor. Almost 85% of the students ratings were very good for the teaching method, classroom management and knowledge level of teachers. Excellent feedback is obtained regarding the aspect about the encouragement/motivation of teachers. The aspect concerning the timely completion of portions, the students ratings were of good enough.

There were a few suggestions;

- 1. The number of toilets are insufficient for the girl students
- 2. Need for additional courses and PG courses.

Action taken report

- 1. As per the feedback suggestions obtained from the students, a new toilet block was constructed for the girl students attached to the girls retiring room.
- 2. Applied for new courses and started a certificate course is Library Science in connection with CACEE (Centre for Adult Continuing education and Extention)
