

IQAC Activity Report 2017-18

IQAC was setup in the college on 15-06-2017. Dr.P.Nazeer, Assistant Professor, Department of Islamic History is selected as the Co-ordinator and Dr. M S Noufal, Dr. P Ashok Nair, Mr. Hashim M, Mr.Dilshad Bin Ashraf and Mrs. Shijina A S, were selected as members.

1. Academic Quality Enhancement

Its first meeting was held at the Principal's chamber on 15-06-2017. As per the decision of the meeting four teaching staff were recommended to start doing their PhD. They were Smt.Mumthas.S, Smt Jasmin.J, Sri.Hashim.M and Asseem.J.

2. Orientation Programme

An orientation programme was conducted by IQAC on 15th July 2017. The Resource person was Dr. Sudheer S.V (Director , HRDC, Kerala University, former NAAC peer team member). He discussed organisation and how the files were to be maintained in the Colleges, Departments and Offices for efficiency.

3. Quality Enhancement of Co-curricular Activities

All the ongoing associations (Nature Club, Islamic history association, Science Club etc.) were reconstituted and new teachers in-charge were assigned for some of the for effective functioning. A few new bodies are formed (commerce association, creativity hub, etc.).

4. Inauguration of Commerce Association

The activities of the Commerce Association was formally inaugurated by Dr. Gabriel Simon Thattil, Professor, Department of Commerce, School of Business Management and Legal Studies, University of Kerala. Dr. Simon Thattil delivered the key note address on the topic "Financial Market".





5. Opening of IQAC Room

A fully furnished IQAC office with facilities such as laptop, printer, scanner, copies, internet facility and LCD projector was launched in the third floor.

6. Observance of Science Promotion Week

The Inauguration of Science Promotion week was celebrated on 14.11.2017 and the programme was inaugurated by Dr. Joshy Joseph, Scientist and Ramanujan Fellow, Photosciences & Photonics Division, NIIST, Trivandrum. The celebration of Science Promotion week-2017 intended to by commemorate the birthdays of Marie Curie, C.V. Raman and Pandit Jawaharlal

Nehru. Dr. Joshy Joseph delivered a lecture on the topic “Functionlized Graphene Nano Conjugates for Sensing and PDT applications”. He briefed on the contributions of Marie Curie, C.V. Raman and also highlighted the significant contributions of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru in the field of Science & Technology. The Speaker explained the type of research activities going on in their institution. His talk came to a formal conclusion by endorsing students to actively engage in research activities.

7. Library Upgradation

As part of library upgradation, a net resource centre was launched in the library on 15th November 2017. The INFLIBNET- NList was implemented in library. WEBOPAC facility too was started and the link was made available in the college website.

8. Community Development Programmes

A noble initiative called “EMPOWER” was started for coordinating numerous community development initiatives envisaged by the college. College has started different beneficial community programmes in nearby village Uliyancode -Uliyancode village a colony located nearby to the college was selected as the adopted village under the National Service Scheme. A Health survey was conducted by NSS in the village. Charity donations were made to several disadvantaged groups through the Snehanidhi programme of National Service Scheme.

9. Pusthakathottil

NSS started another service initiative in the nearby Govt LPS, Kanchinada, as a project launched a project called “pusthakathottil”. Through this initiative, about 150 story books for students were collected from the staff and students of the college and donated the books to the School library.



10. Snehatheeram Visit

Snehatheeram is an institution established to rehabilitate wandering mentally challenged women which organizes, manages, administers and provides shelter, food and clothes for such people. As mentioned in the vision loving care and medication were administered so that they may regain. Periodical visit to the institution were organised to provide them with food, dress and other provisions.

12. Creativity Hub

“Creativity Hub” was established a creative platform with around 50 students, representing every class. The hub was divided into 8 departments viz education, communication, home affairs, industries, HRD etc and have effectively conducted many innovative programmes throughout the year. It was provided with a well-furnished room for personal mentoring and group discussion. The members of the Hub compiled their experiences and released a book on 17/09/2017 “Chernnu Nadakkam Oppam Valaram” edited by the teacher-Coordinator Mr.Dilshad Bin Ashraf.

13. Radio Mandio

The launch of campus radio “ Radio Mandio” by NSS the unit of Mannaniya was yet another attempt to find the talents in the field of communication. It is primarily conceived and technically supported by the National Service Scheme members of the college. The Radio is administered by students in both the telecasting and technical sphere. The radio gets aired everyday for 15 minutes during the lunch break. The telecast commences by a positive thought-bite. The significance of the day is highlighted, followed by the news broadcast. Students from each department are given opportunity to talk about the role of the departments in practical life. The teachers supervise the programs that deal with personality development.





14. State Level Seminar on Green Chemistry and Nano Chemistry

Department of Chemistry and Chemistry Association jointly Organized a state level seminar on topic: Green Chemistry and Nano Chemistry. The Resource Person was Dr. Asif. 
16. One Day Seminar- secularism in a Theo-Democratic Society
