Activity Report

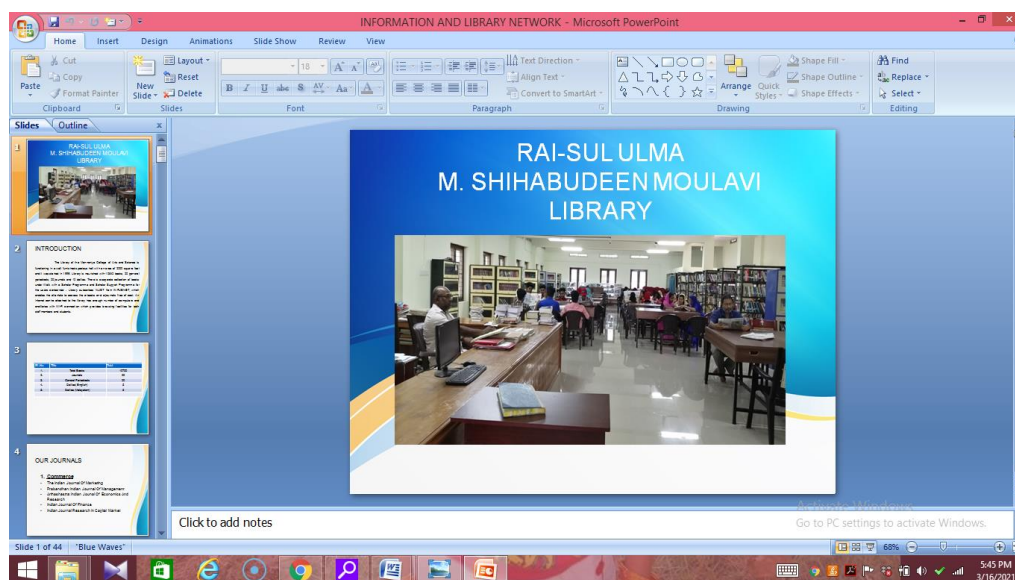
1. Open Forum (19-12-2019)
